Inspired by The Adventure Zone story Commitment Do Good Alliance is about testing the bounds of human morality and billionaires profiting off of public fear. Advanced Bionics is the driving force behind what basically amounts to large corporations betting on horses. Except the horses are humans, and what their choices are when placed under pressure. Does absolute power corrupt absolutely?

Natalie: Short, skinny, 20 year old young woman with shoulder length brown hair, freckles and round rimmed glasses. She is meek and timid, and spends most of her time trying to make herself smaller. She lost her girlfriend in a robbery gone wrong and now dedicates her spare time to random acts of kindness. She cries a lot, but only when she is alone. Very stoic and stone faced. Jason: The Chosen One, the mortal destined to win the war. He is naive but smart, he is hesitant but understands his importance and he is fiercely protective of those that he loves.

Hades: God of the Underworld and the most devoted husband and father. Also the forgotten child of his siblings, he does everything he can to make sure his children feel loved and appreciated. He wants unification but knows that war is upon them regardless of what he wants.

Abigar: The one chosen to lead the Underworld into war, the big sister, the protector. And the one that was forced to grow up too fast to help her younger siblings.

Abbadon: The one who thinks she is leading the Underworld into war, desperately craves her fathers approval and is tired of living in her big sister's shadow. The other side of Athena's coin, she has a soft spot for the mortals, she even fell in love with one once.

Persephone: The mother of the Underworld and the loving wife of Hades possesses magic one can only dream of. She is the guiding hand to all those who seek her advice and her death serves as the catalyst for the start of the war.

Lilith: The youngest of Hades' children. She looks up to her big sisters and wants nothing more than to help the Underworld win this war. But her magic is the weakest so she searches for other means to aid her family.

Triton: The king of the sea is known for his temper, he is demanding and can be cruel. He is focused on nothing other than the war and won't allow his son to get distracted. He craves nothing more than power.

Poseidon: The son of the sea king doesn't want war, he wants to run away with his secret love, but just by being with her, her life is in danger. He tries to challenge his father's rule but it puts both his love and his mother at risk.
